- 1. Call to Order: With a quorum present the meeting was called to order by Chairman Sammy Nygard at 5:30 P.M.
- **2.Public Comments:** Jimi Lou Marchwick-Wix, BTA President, asked the Board if teachers could use covid funding for time off work due to covid exposure. Since it was not on the agenda the Board suggested they discuss it at the regular board meeting.

Erin Solem informed the Board she received a \$3,000 Higher Pathways Grant again this year. It will be used for student college incentives.

Margie Shanks informed the Board it cost \$12,000 to have the school sanitized after Covid outbreak.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Teacher Housing: Ryan Kopp brought a proposal for the purchase of teacher housing.
