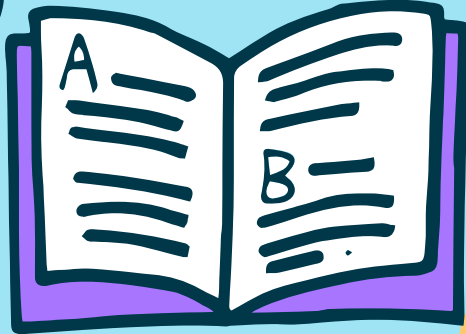

ANNUAL TITLE I MEETING

- Brockton School District will conduct an annual meeting during the month of October, at a convenient time, and encourage and invite all parents of participating children to attend to inform them about the school's Title I program, the nature of the Title I program, the parents' requirements, the school parental engagement policy, the school-wide plan, and the school-parent compact.
- Brockton School District will also offer a flexible number of engagement meetings at convenient times for families, such as meetings in the morning or evening.





JOINTLY DEVELOPED

- Brockton School District will involve parents in an organized, ongoing, and timely way, in the planning, review, and improvement of programs under Title I, Part A, including the planning, review, and improvement of the school parent and family engagement policy and the joint development of the school-wide program plan.





COMMUNICATION

Brockton School District will provide parents of participating children timely information about programs under Title I, including:

- A description and explanation of the program
- Forms of academic assessment used to measure student progress
- Achievement levels of the challenging State academic standards
- If requested by parents, opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to the education of their children and respond to any such suggestions as soon as practicable possible.





SCHOOL & PARENT COMPACT

- Brockton School District will develop, jointly with parents of participating children, a school-parent compact that outlines how families, school, staff, and students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and develop a partnership to help children achieve the state's high standard and how the plan is used, reviewed, and updated.



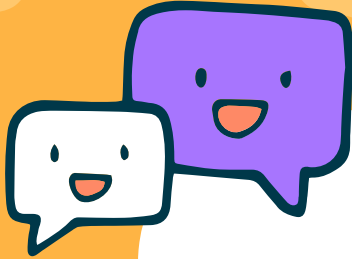


BUILD CAPACITY OF PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- How to work with educators to improve the achievement of their children

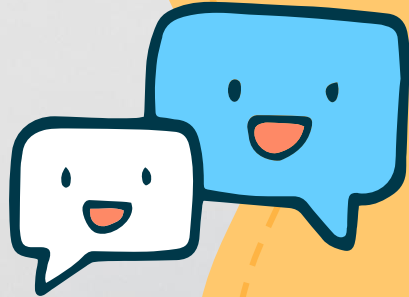
